- 1. What is the first thing that comes to your mind when you hear the word "religion"?
- 2. In the message, it was stated that for many, organized religion has become a system of control. Do you agree or disagree? Why?

Read Hebrews 9:1-10

- 3. How do the religious actions performed by the high priest foreshadow what Jesus would ultimately do on the cross?
- 4. Why were the gifts and sacrifices offered not sufficient enough to clear the consciences of the people? What does this mean for you and I today?

Read Hebrews 9:11-14

- 5. How was Jesus' sacrifice superior to the Day of Atonement?
- 6. Based on Hebrews 9:14, how should Jesus' death on the cross shape the way you live your life today?
- 7. Ask four people to read Romans 3:25, John 15:13, Matthew 27:50-51, and 2 Corinthians 5:17. Discuss all the things Jesus did for us in these verses.
- 8. How might Jesus be calling you to go out and make a difference based on the difference he has made in you?

- 4. Read Hebrews 8:1-6. What are the advantages/better promises that the new covenant is established on?

- 6. Which promise (or promises) are you most susceptible to? Why? What would it look like for you to place your trust in Jesus for these areas instead?
