

## **The Classics Revisited: The Walls of Jericho**

### OVERVIEW

- **The walls didn't fall over from the sound alone. God used a miracle to send the walls down but, if the Israelites didn't trust God, then they wouldn't have defeated Jericho!**

### LESSON GOAL:

Students will end the discussion understanding that believing in God can be challenging and even ridiculous sometimes, but He always works things out for us.

### RELATE

**Have everyone answer to get energy and conversation going.**

1. Has someone asked you to do something crazy before? Did you trust them and do it?
2. How did it work out in the end?

### READ

**Allow students to bring out different truths found in the Bible passage.**

Read Joshua 6:1-21

1. Why do you think God asked the Israelites to march around the city 7 times for a week?
2. Would you say God was specific with his instructions or vague? Why would that matter?
3. How would you describe the faith of the people?

### THINK

**Allow students to bring out different truths found in the world around them.**

1. How do we discern between what God calls us to do and what we just want to do?
2. How do we react when someone asks us to do something that we think is stupid?
3. Do you think God has ever asked you to do something ridiculous? Do you say yes to everything God asks you to do? Why or why not?
4. When you do something ridiculous for God, who can count on to cheer you on?

### LIVE

**Help your students see for themselves what this Biblical truth looks like in their life.**

1. This week your challenge is, to listen to what God may be calling you too. If it sounds crazy, then spend some time in prayer to figure out if it's what God wants from you.
